

TOP TEN PA UNIT & STATION LEADER RESPONSIBILITIES:

PA/PAT Retreat 2016

- 1. Responsible for check-in and check-out, need to check IDs (especially day first day), stay after flag until all campers are checked out, find CORE to discuss concerns on late parents or girls who missed check-out.**
- 2. Resolve camper conflict. Anticipate differences of opinion and ways to share input from campers. Seek CORE if needed.**
- 3. Ensure buddy system is being used and girls always have buddy.**
- 4. Count campers when transitioning.**
- 5. Check on dietary restrictions and allergies. We suggest one leader at front and one at end of lunch line. Verify they are eating their lunches and drinking plenty water.**
- 6. Enforce camp rules and group agreement. I.e Tree climbing, river ban, treatment of each other,etc.**
- 7. Use time management! Be aware of time (not an invitation to constantly use your phone). Allow time to get to stations. Be on-time to morning meetings! Give girls transitional warnings..."we will be moving in 3 minutes".**
- 8. Leave it better than you found it! Clean up every day. All trash picked up after snacks/lunches and unit box returned.**
- 9. Participate actively at stations. Help your stations leaders with the activity. This is not break time.**
- 10. Have fun! Are each of your campers having a fun, safe, and productive day.**
