We must have any special diet information BY JULY _____ (date TBA) so that the unit menu can be adjusted before camp starts.
- Snacks will be provided every day; each camper needs to bring one RESEALABLE, REUSABLE
 PLASTIC CONTAINER (about 2 cup size) to hold morning snacks and afternoon snacks.
- nake sure your camper dresses appropriately for the weather and for camp in general. We will be enforcing our DRESS CODE for camper safety (while hiking around camp and cooking with fire). Campers without appropriate shoes/shorts will be able to call their parents and wait in the Barn until appropriate shoes/shorts are brought to camp.

SHOES: CLOSED toe shoes or CLOSED toe sandals, please.

SHORTS: Pant legs should be arms-length (finger tips) or longer

UNIFORMS: Your unit will be performing the flag ceremony on _____. Please bring your vest/sash to wear during the ceremony. Honor guard sashes are available from camp as needed.

THEME DAYS: Campers vote for the theme of the day Tuesday through Thursday. It is not required to dress up, but campers do find it fun. Past examples: stuffed animal day, crazy hair day, pj day, super hero day, etc. Camp t-shirts need to still be worn each day.
